

RESOLUTION NUMBER 00-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT
MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE
“JOINT PUBLIC INFORMATION STRATEGY
FOR FLOOD AND HURRICANE MITIGATION ”;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Lee County and its municipalities are vulnerable to flooding threats from stormwater runoff and storm surges caused by tropical weather systems; and

WHEREAS, with the approval of Resolution No. 99-08-07, The Board of County Commissioners adopted the Lee County Floodplain Management/Hazard Mitigation Plan to guide planning and implementation of activities to reduce damage and health and safety risks from flooding; and

WHEREAS, The Lee County Disaster Advisory Council has prepared a joint public information strategy that reviews county and municipal programs and activities to increase public awareness to the flood hazards, flood protection and safety measures, and other flood information; and

WHEREAS, the joint public information strategy will assist all communities in Lee County in planning and implementing a coordinated public awareness of activities that benefit the general health and safety of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH,
that:


1. The Joint Public Information Strategy for Flood and Hurricane Mitigation is hereby adopted as a strategy to inform the citizens of Lee County of their flood risk and what measures can be taken to protect themselves and their property from harm.
2. This Resolution becomes effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




