

**RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY OF THE
TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION NUMBER 2007-02**

WHEREAS, the existence of the Local Planning Agency (LPA) is mandated by Florida Statutes Section 163.3174; and

WHEREAS, the Local Planning Agency is statutorily responsible under Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, and the Town of Fort Myers Land Development Code (LDC) Section 34-120 for the review of proposed land development regulations, land development codes, or amendments thereto, and for making recommendations to the Town Council with regard thereto; and

WHEREAS, following proper notice and as required under Florida Statute and the LDC, the LPA conducted a Public Hearing on February 27, 2007, to review Ordinance 07-03, which would amend regulations set forth in Chapters 14 and 27 of the LDC to modify and add definitions; add new provisions regarding beach furniture and equipment; modify provisions regarding beach raking, and add a new provision regarding beach furniture and equipment licenses; in the LDC.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

1. that the LPA recommends approval and adoption of Ordinance 07-03 by the Town Council on behalf of the Town of Fort Myers Beach, Florida; and
2. that the Town Council direct the Town Manager to develop an ongoing plan to refine the parameters for when raking is allowed under extraordinary circumstances and report to the Town Council on the progress of this plan on an annual basis.
3. that the Town Council publicize each raking event.


The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the LPA upon a motion by Bob Raymond and second by Larry Kiker. Upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


