

RESOLUTION 17-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, ENDORSING THE CALOOSAHATCHEE WATERSHED REGIONAL WATER MANAGEMENT ISSUES, VERSION 3.0; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach shares common interests and concerns with other coastal communities of Lee County with respect to water quality; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sanibel has provided to the coastal communities in Lee County a white paper entitled the Caloosahatchee Watershed Regional Water Management Issues, Version 3.0 and has requested an endorsement of the document; and

WHEREAS, the white paper provides comprehensive goals and strategies to address the Kissimmee, Lake Okeechobee and Caloosahatchee water resource issues and is periodically revised and updated to address current best practices and approaches with respect to water quality and water resource protection; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to endorse the white paper in support of a collective and comprehensive approach to the watershed issues that are of paramount importance to the residents and visitors of Lee County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby endorses the Caloosahatchee Watershed Regional Water Management Issues, Volume 3.0, a copy of which is attached hereto, in order to provide general agreement with other coastal communities in Lee County concerning the approach to water quality and water resource protection.

SECTION 2. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign any documents related to the endorsement of the document entitled *Caloosahatchee Watershed Regional Water Management Issues, Volume 3.0*.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon motion by Vice Mayor Hosafros and seconded by Council Member Shamp, and being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


