



## Town of Fort Myers Beach Department of Community Development Garbage Collection Services Information

### **THURSDAY- REGULAR GARBAGE COLLECTION:**

- **Garbage/containers may not be placed to the curbside more than 24 hours before scheduled pick up**
- **All containers must be removed from the curbside within 24 hours after pick up and stored away from the public view.**
- Properties that are in need of additional pick up and or weekend/Saturday pick up may contact Advanced Disposal and contract this service at an additional charge
- Property owners and managers of rental properties are responsible for ensuring their tenants comply with the garbage collection regulations
- Garbage must be placed within 6 feet of the curb by 6:30am on day of pick up
- Garbage must be placed in a container of 40 gallon capacity or less, with weather proof/animal proof, seal tight lid and a handle on each side or suitable heavy mil plastic bags.
- No container or bag may exceed 50 pounds
- Bulky items that are to be picked up with the garbage collection (sofas, chairs, mattresses, etc.) may not be placed to the curbside more than 24 hours before scheduled pick up. These items may require a special pick up.

### **WEDNESDAY RECYCLING COLLECTION:**

- **Recycling/containers may not be placed to the curbside more than 24 hours before scheduled pick up**
- **All containers must be removed from the curbside within 24 hours after pick up and stored away from the public view.**
- Properties that are in need of additional pick up and or weekend/Saturday pick up may contact Advanced Disposal and contract this service at an additional charge
- Property owners and managers of rental properties are responsible for ensuring their tenants comply with the garbage collection regulations
- Corrugated cardboard boxes are to be broken down flat and not exceed 4 feet by 6 feet and 6 inches thick
- Commingled glass, aluminum, plastic and glass may be placed in the blue recycle totes. Please do not place any recyclables in plastic bags.
- Bottles, jars and cans must be free of residuals.
- Place newspapers, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, computer and office paper, junk mail and envelopes into separate paper bags or request an additional recycling bin for paper products
- Do not place garbage or yard waste in recycling bin.

### **WEDNESDAY YARD WASTE COLLECTION:**

- **Yard waste may not be placed to the curbside more than 24 hours before scheduled pick up**
- **Containers must be removed from the curbside within 24 hours after pick up and stored away from the public view.**
- Properties that are in need of additional pick up and or weekend/Saturday pick up may contact Advanced Disposal and contract this service at an additional charge
- Property owners and managers of rental properties are responsible for ensuring their tenants comply with the garbage collection regulations
- Yard waste must be placed in containers of 40 gallon capacity or less, with a handle on each side, or securely ties in bundles that are no longer than 6 feet and weigh no more than 50 pounds per bundle or container
- Unbundled palm fronds may be placed at curbside in neat stacks of less than 50 pounds
- Do not place yard waste on empty lots
