As stated in Ordinance 99-6, Section 3 – Declaration of state of emergency; authority of responsible official. "...Whenever a quorum of the town council is unavailable or unable to meet within a time reasonable under the circumstances to safely and properly react to such emergency, a state of local emergency may be declared by the following officials in the event all those listed precedent to each of such officials are unavailable or unable to be contacted: the mayor, vice-mayor, any town council member, the responsible official..."

Pursuant to Ordinance 99-6 Councilman Rynearson signed Resolution 04-27 declaring a local state of emergency for the Town of Fort Myers Beach.
