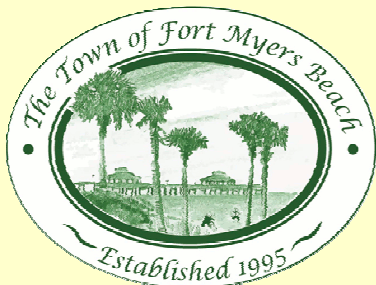

Town of Fort Myers Beach Top Ten for September

1. **BUDGET – Council budget hearings will be at 6:30 p.m. on September 7 and September 21.** A copy can be downloaded from the Town's website or if you would like more information or have questions, contact Maureen Rischitelli at 239-765-0202 ext. 1200.
2. **FRIGHT NIGHT SAVE THE DATE – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 20 from 6 PM – 9 PM. At Bay Oaks. Come and volunteer** Contact Sarah Mayher at 765-4222 or stop by Bay Oaks.
3. **PERMITS & PLANS – EPLAN IS NOW AVAILABLE –** Community Development has implemented Eplan, a web based application which allows you to electronically submit your permits online and download the approved plans from your computer. If you need more information contact Kendra Ricketts or Misty Alexander at Town Hall 239-765-0202.
4. **PARKING NEWS –** Vehicle Registration will be withheld for Unpaid Parking Tickets. The Town of Fort Myers Beach is implementing registration holds for those who have 3 outstanding parking tickets or 1 outstanding handicap violation. If you have questions contact Doug Molloy at 239-463-5888.
5. **WATER & STORMWATER PROJECT –** Construction on Eucalyptus Court is expected to begin after Labor Day (9/4)! Jefferson Street construction is expected to begin shortly thereafter. Improvements on these streets will include new water main and new storm drain. Once the installation of the water main and storm drain is complete and all service connections are made, crews will regrade and pave the roadway and restore the right-of-way (ROW). Construction on each street is expected to be completed in approximately four months. More details and continued updates can be found on the Town's website.

The pool heaters will keep water temperature in a range of 82-85 degrees. Pool Maintenance for the winter is tentatively scheduled for Jan 2-Jan 14.
