

RESOLUTION NUMBER 18-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ADMINISTRATIVELY INCREASE BY ONE-HALF CENT SALES TAX TO THOSE CHARGES AND FEES SUBJECT TO FLORIDA STATE SALES TAX

WHEREAS: On November 6, 2018, by referendum, the voters of Lee County approved a one-half cent increase to the state sales tax now levied pursuant to law; and,

WHEREAS: The Town of Fort Myers Beach when applicable charged sales tax for those goods and services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach, Florida that the Town Manager will make the appropriate adjustments to qualifying Town sales of goods, merchandise or services and levy the one-half cent sales tax increase to those charges when so required.


