

EMERGENCY ORDER #2 – HURRICANE MILTON

(Pursuant to Resolution 24-214)

AN EMERGENCY ORDER OF THE TOWN MANAGER OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH RELATED TO HURRICANE MILTON; REPEALING THE MANDATORY EVACUATION; REPEALING THE CURFEW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2024, the Town Manager issued Emergency Order #1, providing for an emergency evacuation and establishing a curfew within the Town; and

WHEREAS, in light of the improving conditions on Estero Island, the mandatory evacuation order and imposition of a curfew is no longer needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Town Manager of the Town of Fort Myers Beach that:

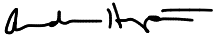
SECTION 1. Findings. The above recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. Repealing a Mandatory Evacuation. The mandatory evacuation order is hereby repealed effective 11:00 a.m., Sunday, October 13, 2024.

SECTION 3. Repealing Curfew. Beginning at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 13, 2024 the previously imposed curfew is hereby lifted.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect immediately upon execution unless earlier modified or terminated by a written Order by the Town Manager.
