

RESOLUTION NO: 25-246

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING AN EMERGENCY CONTACT AND AN ALTERNATE EMERGENCY CONTACT AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 252.38(3)(a), FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR NOTIFICATION OF SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2025, the Governor approved Senate Bill 180 (“SB 180”), which amended, in pertinent part, certain statutory provisions related to the designation of emergency contacts, as set forth in the newly amended Section 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes (2025); and

WHEREAS, under the newly amended Section 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes (2025), each municipality must notify the Florida Division of Emergency Management within the Executive Office of the Governor, or the successor to that division, on or before May 1 of each year of the person designated as the emergency contact for the municipality and his or her alternate and of any changes in persons so designated thereafter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF EMERGENCY CONTACT AND ALTERNATE EMERGENCY CONTACT. The Town Council hereby designates the following individuals to serve as the Town’s emergency contact and alternate emergency contact, respectively, as specified in Section 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes (2025):

Emergency Contact: Will McKannay, Town Manager

Alternate Emergency Contact: Thomas Yozzo, Emergency Services Director

SECTION 2. NOTIFICATION TO THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. The Town Manager is directed to notify the Florida Division of Emergency Management within the Executive Office of the Governor, or the successor to that division, of the person designated as the emergency contact for the Town and his or her alternate, and of any changes in persons so designated before May 1st of each year and upon adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and passage.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Town Council upon a motion by Council Member King and seconded by Council Member Woodson and upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:
